

Fruit Varieties

APPLE (need two different varieties for cross-pollination)

CORTLAND: These medium-large slightly ribbed dull red fruit with a purple blush have a slow-oxidizing white flesh which means they won't brown! The fine-grained, tart, crisp, juicy fruit is excellent for eating and cooking. Ripens mid-September. Mature height: 12-15 ft.; Plant Spacing: 12-15 ft.; Years to fruit: 3-5

HONEYCRISP: An "explosively crisp", mottled and striped red over yellow medium-large fruit, honeycrisps have cream-colored flesh that is sweet and juicy. The tree blooms mid-late season and fruit ripens in early fall. Mature height: 12-15 ft.; Plant Spacing: 12-15 ft.; Years to fruit: 2-5

AZTEC FUJI: The reddest blush Fuji on the market, Aztec apples have a sweet flavor and crisp crunch. Late season harvest. Mature height: 12-15 ft.; Plant Spacing: 12-15 ft.; Years to fruit: 2-5

SWEET CHERRY

LAPINS: This self-fruitful, Bing-type cherry produces large crops of delicious dark fruit nearly one inch in diameter. Its purplish red flesh is firm and sweet. Showy pinkish-white flowers appear mid-spring followed by a prolific harvest from late June to early July. Mature height: 15-25 ft.; Plant Spacing: 15-20 ft.; Years to fruit: 1

PEAR (need two different varieties for cross-pollination)

STARKING DELICIOUS: Producing abundant, smooth, sweet and juicy pears that are a favorite for canning, this tree is disease-resistant to fireblight and a strong pollinator for most other pears. Harvest in early September. Mature height: 20 ft.; Plant Spacing: 18-20 ft.; Years to fruit: 4-6

BARTLETT: A large, greenish-yellow and classically oblong variety, this multi-purpose fruit features a smooth, firm texture and a juicy, spicy taste. The long-lived tree is large, vigorous, and easy-to-grow. Ripens in late August. Mature height: 20 ft.; Plant Spacing: 18-20 ft.; Years to fruit: 4-6

PEACH

REDHAVEN: A large variety with almost fuzzless skin over firm, creamy textured yellow flesh. This luscious, top-quality fruit is great as a fresh snack or for canning and freezing. The tree is heavy-bearing and easy to grow and maintain. Ripens in early August. Mature height: 15-18 ft.; Plant Spacing: 15-20 ft.; Years to fruit: 2-4

PLUM (need two different varieties for cross-pollination)

NOTE: plums are a finicky fruit to grow. Early frosts and heavy rains can effect fruit set, tight spacing is required to get adequate pollination.

SATSUMA: A large, dark red, sweet plum prized for canning and eating right off the tree. This Asian plum is firmer and larger than European plums. Ripens in late July and early August. Mature height: 12-15 ft.; Plant Spacing: 6-8 ft.; Years to fruit: 3-4

SHIRO: Luminous yellow skin covers sweet, juicy flesh on this heavy bearing variety. Shiro grows clusters of clingstone plums all throughout the tree. Ripens in late July and early August. Mature height: 12-15 ft.; Plant Spacing: 6-8 ft.; Years to fruit: 3-6

RHUBARB

'VICTORIA': produces early, abundant crops that are great for cooking. Large, tender, rosy-red stalks are sweeter and milder than other varieties.. Mature Height: 3-4ft.; Plant Spacing: 4 ft.; Years to fruit: 1, larger harvest in year 3

RASPBERRY

'HERITAGE' EVER-BEARING produces abundant crops of large, sweet, dark red berries that are perfect for eating fresh, canning, freezing, or making jams and jellies. Self-supporting, upright canes are hearty enough to grow in poor soil, but requires a well-drained site. Cold-hardy. Mature height: 4 - 5 ft.; Plant Spacing: 3 - 4 ft; Years to fruit: 1-2

SASKATOON

'REGENT' When fully ripe, dark blue fruit has a nice sweet-tart flavor balance with a hint of almond. Highly recommended for all wild food enthusiasts who enjoy blueberries but don't have the type of ground to grow them. Saskatoons have ten times more vitamin C than blueberries. Mature height: 4-5 ft.; Plant Spacing: 3 ft. Years to fruit: 1

GRAPE

'CANDICE SEEDLESS' is an easy-to-grow early ripening seedless grape that bears great crops even after hard winters. The fruit grows in compact grape clusters 6-8 inches long and bears medium-size, firm, red grapes that keep well on the vine. Self-pollinating. Mature height: trellis up to 8ft. Plant Spacing: 5-8 ft. Years to bear: 2-4

STRAWBERRY

'HONEOYE' are a dark red fruit, delicious fresh, frozen, or in jams. This hardy, consistent producer bears crops reliably, with good runner production. Ripens in June. Self-pollinating. Mature height: 12 in; Plant Spacing: 12 inches; Years to fruit: 1
