KGD is building a team of seasoned growers to support our garden development staff this spring

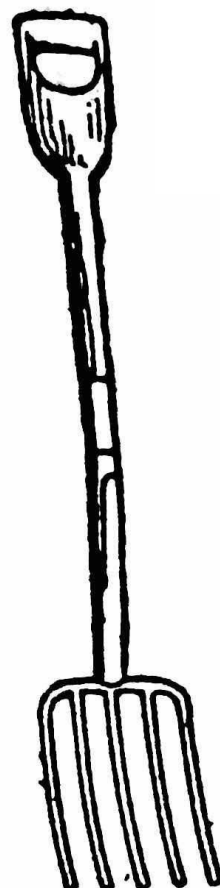
Each growing season, Keep Growing Detroit supports the development of hundreds of gardens across Detroit, Highland Park, and Hamtramck. A big part of this support is working directly with community members to give advice about their projects, conduct soil testing, and spread the news about the resources available to help gardens grow. Keep Growing Detroit is looking for community members to join the GRP Pride this spring to support our staff with these efforts and help grow the GRP!

What is the GRP Pride?

- The GRP Pride is a team of 3-5 seasoned growers that works with KGD's garden development staff during the spring months (mid-March through mid-June of 2018).
- Responsibilities include assisting with outreach efforts, soil testing at gardens across the city, and other new garden development activities.
- Members of the GRP Pride will receive a stipend for their time and work 2-5 hours per week for a total of 30 hours.
- Training is mandatory and will be provided.

GRP Pride Qualifications:

- Have 3+ years of gardening experience. Urban Roots graduates and gardeners who completed agricultural training programs in Detroit are strongly encouraged to apply!
- Be a Garden Resource Program member.
- Have reliable transportation.
- Enjoy working with all types of people.
- Have a flexible schedule, some events may be during evenings or weekends.
- All applications will be considered; ideal candidates will be asked to interview in person.
