WATER COLLECTION SYSTEMS FOR URBAN GARDENERS AND FARMERS

In an effort to help growers conserve and protect fresh water, Keep Growing Detroit (KGD) is seeking applications from established community, school, or market gardens in the Garden Resource Program that are interested in installing water collection systems to help irrigate their established gardens and farms. This program is application based. Successful applications will receive support designing and installing a customized water collection system.

Water Wise Water Collection System Options

- 275 gallon tank(s) attached to the gutter of an adjacent building with permission from the owner
- A new free standing structure with attached water collection tank(s)
- Installation of gutters and tanks at an established hoophouse
- Other designs will be considered at the discretion of KGD

Eligibility

- Site must be a 2019 Garden Resource Program member
- Site must participate in a site visit to assess water needs and system design
- Site must attend the Water Wise Workshop on May 4th from 2-5PM at Georgia Street Community Center, 8902 Vinton

Requirements of Awardees

If selected a representative from your site must:

- A representative from the project must attend a pre-construction meeting on May 14, 6-7:30PM at the KGD Office, 1445 Adelaide
- A representative from the project must contribute at least 3 hours of labor to your build AND 3 hours to assist with another site's build

How to Apply

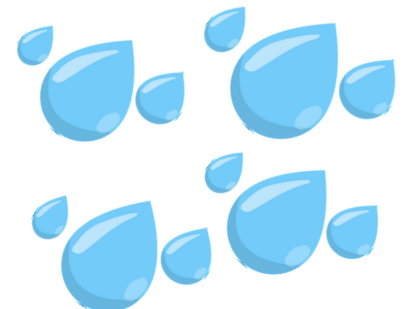
Completed applications are due by May 4th, 2019.
